

## Mandatory Items to Bring for Eligibility for the Making Work Count Program:

1. **Income Information** – Which could include **ONE** of the following -**Notice of Action, Food Stamp Card, Medi-Cal Card** and **ALL** household income for the **past 30 days** - Total Gross Monthly Income Cannot Exceed 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) – See Income Types list for included income.

2. **The household utility bill with in past 30 days to verify residency**

3. **Birth Certificate for applicant and all children age 17 and younger in home.**

(See Verification of Child Existence & Relationship to Applicant for additional options.)

4. **Applicants Current Photo Identification -**

Which could include: a Non Expired Drivers License, DMV Identification Card, Passport, School Identification

5. **Applicants Signed Social Security Card**
